Jerking of different parts of the body  
Yelling or Screaming  
Squinting of the eyes  
Knee Bending  
Talking to oneself  
Belching  
Barking  
Echolalia  
Echopraxia  
Grimacing  
Eye Blinking  
Grunting  
Tearing things  
Twirling Hair  
Stuttering  
Kicking  
Jumping  
Humming  
Hopping  
Head Jerking  
Hair Twisting  
Licking Lips  
Pinching  
Pulling Hair  
Gurgling noises  
Hiccuping  
Snorting  
Smelling Things  
Stooping down  
Sucking  
Moaning  
Shrugging of the Shoulders  
Arm Flapping  
Flexing of the ankles or legs  
Shouting  
Clearing their throat

While this list is of course not conclusive, these are some common motor and vocal tics observed in patients with Tourette's syndrome or vocal and/or motor tic disorders.
